Highlights: 4 nights Hervey Bay, Whale Watch Cruise, Fraser Island day tour

Day 1. Central Coast to Grafton (LD)

Travelling north today along the M1, we take in the views of the amazing Manning, Hastings and Macleay Rivers. Our Journey will take us through the towns of Raymond Terrace and into Taree for a delicious lunch stop at Taree RSL. We then continue through Coffs Harbour and into Grafton for our overnight stay.

Today we will see this famous farm and enjoy tea & pumpkin scones with the family. From Kingaroy we continue to Dalby. This region is renowned as a rich agricultural area, growing crops such as cotton, sorghum, wheat, barley and sunflowers.

Day 9. Dalby – Glen Innes (BD)

A town tour of Dalby this morning before heading off for another travelling day, crossing the rich soil plains. Our journey will take us through Toowoomba, Warwick and Stanthorpe before crossing the border back into NSW. Visit the township of Tenterfield, home to the famous Tenterfield Saddler. Glen Innes is our destination today for our last night.

Balance of payment for your holiday is to be paid 45 days prior to departure.
